Start Time: Fri. 10:00 am

Running Order: Instinct, Novice, Open, Senior, Master, Crazy 8's. Small to Tall. Dogs will be run in height order with dogs being handled by the same person separated into different blinds.

Height Divisions:

Small- Dogs <13"

Medium- Dogs 13.1" to 18"

Large- Dogs over 18"

All dogs **MUST** be on a short leash and under control while on the test grounds except while showing. Approved collars include flat snap or buckle collars of solid construction, prong collars, and leather or nylon leads. Single piece slip collars/leads are allowed. Harnesses, with the exception of head halter types, are allowed. Dogs must run "naked", without a collar/harness. Flexi-leads are NOT PERMITTED on the grounds. Pet waste containers are available outside the building. Please pick up after your dog.

Crating: There is plenty of crating space available. Please make sure your crate is secure as the dogs may become highly excited. Limited crates are also available on site to be used by competitions.

Facility: It is held indoors in a heated facility. There are indoor restrooms available on site. **PEASE NOTE:** The Barn Hunt area is upstairs! Blinds and crating will take place downstairs.

Bitches in Season: Bitches in season are eligible for entry but will be required to be kept separate from the other dogs. Bitches must wear "panties", and will run at the end of their class level. If bringing a bitch in season, please inform the test secretary prior to the test to inform all exhibitors at the judges briefing.
